







### “Save For Service Provider” feature


This feature will save you money, time and frustration by collecting all of your support graphics and fonts and packaging them together with a report.



When you are ready to bring your PageMaker file in for digital output, use the **Save For Service Provider** in the **Plug-ins** submenu of the **Utilities** menu.



Click on **Package...**



Select a location for the collected files (we suggest creating a new folder). Under **Include** check the **Copy fonts:** and **All** options as shown. Also check the **Update links in source pub** option. Now, click on **Save**.

### Black and White or Color Laser Imaging


When bringing files for digital output:


### Spot or Full Color Offset Printing

When bringing files for digital output:

- Use the **Remove Unused Colors** command in the Color Palette.
